- I. **Ecclesiastes 11:7&8:** Old Age is Coming
  - A. Old age from Solomon’s point of view.  
**Ecclesiastes 11:7&8**
    - 1. There will be many days of darkness.
    - 2. Life will appear to be empty and meaningless.
  - B. Old age from David’s point of view.  
**Psalms 92:12-14**
    - 1. Those who are planted in the house of the Lord will flourish.
    - 2. There will be meaning as they bear fruit & are productive.
  
- II. **Ecclesiastes 11:9:** God will bring you into judgment. You will reap what you sow. (**Galatians 6:7&8**)
  - A. Solomon and God’s judgment. **1 Kings 11:1-10**
  - B. David and God’s judgment. **2 Samuel 12:9-14**
  
- III. **Ecclesiastes 11:10:** Youth is a dangerous time in your life. Don’t do anything that will harm you and bring about emptiness in your youth and consequently later in life.
  - A. Solomon’s youth:
    - 1. God appears twice to him when he was young. **1 Kings 3:5** and **1 Kings 9:2**
    - 2. **Ecclesiastes 2:1-11:** Major experimentation leads to emptiness.

  - B. David and God’s judgment. **2 Samuel 12:9-14**
  
- III. **Ecclesiastes 11:10:** Youth is a dangerous time in your life. Don’t do anything that will harm you and bring about emptiness in your youth and consequently later in life.
  - A. Solomon’s youth:
    - 1. God appears twice to him when he was young. **1 Kings 3:5** and **1 Kings 9:2**
    - 2. **Ecclesiastes 2:1-11:** Major experimentation leads to emptiness.

- B. David's youth:
1. **Psalms 71:17&18** Taught from his youth.
  2. **1 Samuel 17:33-37** Major exploits with God.

- IV. **Ecclesiastes 12:1:** Remember God now when you are young so that when you are old you will still have pleasure and delight in a relationship with God.
- A. Youth is the time when you start to lay the foundation for your life. **1 Corinthians 3:11-13**
- B. Solomon in his old age: His heart was not perfect with God. **1 Kings 11:4**
1. Was Solomon able to repent and feel sorrow for his sins? Some believe he did and that the books of Proverbs & Ecclesiastes were his attempt to warn youth of the dangers that await them.
- C. David was older too when he sinned. David was able to repent, feel sorrow for his sins, and restore his relationship with God.
