Our Beliefs in Brief : #7 - The Nature of Humanity

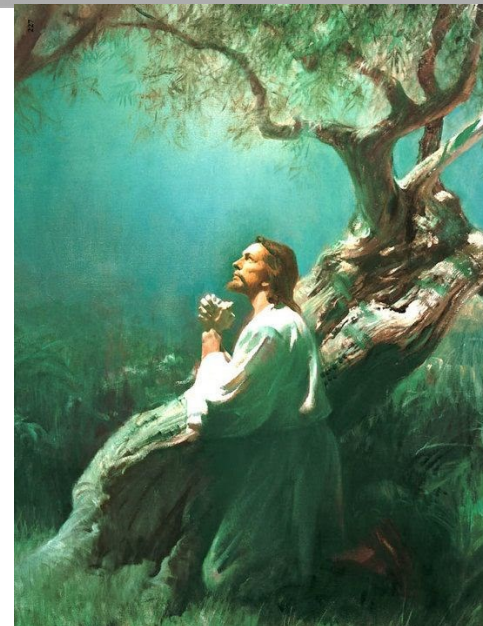
