- I. Island Peak (20,210 feet), the Rope, and Faith.
  - A. In the past, I thought that the best verb for faith was rest. Hebrews 4:3
  - B. The definition of sin found in 1 John 4:3 says that sin is the transgression of the law.
- C. How does this definition fit with Romans 14:23? Does "rest" make more sense? We are missing something with our understanding of faith and sin.
  - D. Hebrews 11:6 without faith it is impossible to please God. "Resting" or "Trusting"?
- "Depending" seems to fit the best. Try reading depending for faith through the entire chapter.
- II. What Is the Shield of Faith in Ephesians 6:16?
- A. We can't quench the fiery darts ourselves. So in *dependence* on Jesus we submit to His will. "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." James 4:6
- III. How are we "to live by faith"? Habakkuk 2:4
  - A. Live by "resting"? Maybe
  - B. Live by "depending" upon God. Better
- IV. How do we "walk by faith and not by sight"? 2 Corinthians 5:17
  - A. Walk by "resting"? Does not seem to fit well.
  - B. We walk by depending on God and not by sight.
- V. Romans 14:23 Could it be that independence from God is sin?
- VI. Faith has different meanings depending upon our circumstances. Believing, trusting, resting, and now depending.
  - A. The rope and victory over Island Peak.
